Dear Members, please disregard previous email from <no-reply@surfguard.slsa.asn.au - 26th Sept> regarding requal day.

As usual, you will have to do your on-line assessment PRIOR to attending the requal and at the end of the assessment you can register for the Practical – it would be appreciated if you would please do this as soon as possible so that we have an idea of how many candidates we'll have on the day.

On-line assessment and booking for Practical can be found at www.mt.lsv-from-anywhere.com.au. Please ensure you take a screenshot on your phone or print out the final Certificate to bring along for the practical as evidence that you have successfully completed the on-line assessment (it is also possible to login to your profile at the Club to display the Certificate if necessary).

Requal (Skills Assessment) day is **10.00am** Saturday 25th Oct beginning with **BNZ, SRC & First Aid** and hopefully completed well before 12.30pm.

Specialty Awards will follow after lunch break and will start no later than 1.30pm with view to being completed no later than 3.00pm.

First-Aid candidates have to do CPR annually, and **cannot be assessed** along with BNZ & SRC in the morning. First Aid Only candidates will need to attend a special First Aid upgrade, which will be run at 2.00pm and should be completed prior to 3.30pm

IRBD & IRBC will be assessed again this season with a full practical and candidates **MUST** bring their **Marine License** to the requal day. IRBC & IRBD assessments will be done between **12.00pm** and 1.00pm.

If any candidate has a specific time that they need to be at work or another engagement, then please confirm with me prior to 10.00am on the day

In the event you don't complete your on-line assessment prior to the day, we will have laptops available as usual for you at the Club from **9.00am** – we will have assessors available to assist up until 10.00am but unavailable after then. If you turn up at 10.00am without having done your online assessment, it is likely you may miss the land-based practical assessment once the main group moves onto the water-work.

Subject to demand, it is likely that we will run a smaller **additional requal opportunity prior to 1st Jan** – a proposed date will be published after 25th Nov. Please remember, that you cannot patrol nor are you insured after 1st Jan if you have not requalified at least the BNZ or SRC Award. If you are unable to attend either of the Sorrento requals then there are over a dozen requal days at other Clubs in our Region between now and Christmas.
