

# Skills Maintenance 2018 – 10.00am, 1<sup>st</sup> Dec

As usual, you will have to do your on-line assessment **PRIOR** to attending the requal and at the end of the assessment you can register for the Practical – it would be appreciated if you would please do this as soon as possible so that we have an idea of how many candidates we'll have on the day.

On-line assessment and booking for Practical can be found at [www.mt.lsv-from-anywhere.com.au](http://www.mt.lsv-from-anywhere.com.au). Please ensure you take a **screenshot** on your phone or **print** out the final Certificate to bring along for the practical as evidence that you have successfully completed the on-line assessment (it is also possible to login to your profile at the Club to display the Certificate if necessary).

Requal (Skills Assessment) day is **10.00am** Saturday 1 December 2018 beginning with **BNZ, SRC & First Aid** and hopefully completed well before 12.30pm.

**Specialty Awards** (including the ARTC[AID] update) will follow after a lunch break and will start no later than 1.30pm with view to being completed no later than 3.00pm. ARTC[AID] upgrade candidates need to enrol in the ARTC [AID] (new) course **not** the SM.

**First-Aid** candidates have to do CPR annually, and will be assessed along with BNZ & SRC from 10.00am. First Aid Only candidates should be completed prior to 11.30am First Aid candidates need to enrol in Resuscitation Course (not SM)

**IRBD & IRBC** will be assessed again this season with a full practical and candidates **MUST** bring their **Marine License** to the requal day. IRBC & IRBD assessments will be done between **12.30pm** and 1.30pm.

If any candidate has a **specific time** that they need to be at work or another engagement, then please confirm with me prior to 10.00am on the day

The Clubhouse will be open by **9.00am** for anyone wanting a quick revision and there we will be assessors available to assist up until 10.00am but unavailable after then. If you turn up at 10.00am without having done your online assessment, it is likely you may miss the land-based practical assessment once the main group moves onto the water-work.

Subject to demand, it is likely that we will run a smaller **additional requal opportunity prior to 1<sup>st</sup> Jan** – a proposed date will be published after 1 December. Please remember, that you cannot patrol, do water safety nor are you insured after 1<sup>st</sup> Jan if you have not requalified at least the BNZ or SRC Award. If you are unable to attend either of the Sorrento requals, then there are over a dozen requal days at other Clubs in our Region between now and Christmas.
