## PRESIDENT'S REPORT

It is with great pleasure that I present the Sorrento Surf Life Saving Club 2019-20 Annual Report.

It's been an interesting year on many levels, both fun and challenging at times, as we've not only had to deal with our regular beach related activities but also the bushfires over the new year and more recently, COVID-19 which forced the early shut down of our season.

Many of our Members were involved in the bushfire recovery efforts, and we thank everyone for the effort they put in.

Challenges aside, we've had yet another successful year in the surf. Our patrollers acquitted themselves nicely throughout the season, and although the number of rescues and incidents was down, this doesn't take away anything from the importance of what they do and the effort they put in maintaining safety on our beach – something we can all be proud of.

It was pleasing to see good numbers of new patrollers hitting the beach again this and the enthusiasm they showed in getting out there and being actively involved was fantastic. I'd personally like to thank each and every patroller for the work they do on our beach – I know at times it can be challenging but without them, our beach wouldn't be the safe and family friendly space that it is today.

There have been a number of initiatives progressing in the background over this past year. Pleasingly, we had a number of new Committee Members join at last year's AGM and this has allowed us to commence some new projects and complete some ongoing ones.

Our clubhouse has undergone a number of upgrades in the past 12 months. We have upgraded security with the installation of CCTV cameras and implemented a new access system. Both of these mean enhanced safety for our Members and their clubhouse and will allow Members greater access and amenity within the clubrooms over the coming years.

We have also formed a number of sub-committees (or working groups) to start to focus on some of the bigger picture stuff that does not fall into the 'business as usual' category.

The formation of a Youth Advisory Committee is a great example of our younger Members stepping up to become more involved in our club. They are the future leaders of the club and it has been really nice to see so many of them wanting to have a say in how the club functions. Gina Fothergill has led this initiative and I'd like to thank her and the group of youth Members involved for pursuing this.

The committee has also spent some time examining how we would like our club to evolve in the future. A business planning working group has been established to do some forward planning and start work on a 10-20 year business plan. The working group is looking at what we want to offer our Members and how we will do this in coming years.

For a couple of years now, there has been talk about upgrading our clubrooms. A small sub group has started some initial exploratory thinking about what this could look like and how we may achieve it. We have been successful in finding a local benefactor who has offered to fund some initial draft plans for a future building and assist us in exploring/gaining planning permits

and the like. This is a really exciting piece of work and we hope to be able to share with Members some draft plans in the very near future.

In the coming year we also hope to start looking into a new Membership system that will make it easier for our Members to renew annually and implementing a more robust Working With Children Check system.

Our Members have also had a successful year. Four of our nippers were selected to attend Victorian training camps but unfortunately COVID meant the camps did not go ahead. One of our patrollers, **Erin Doupe**, was recognised by Life Saving Victoria (**LSV**) as part of their Internal Women's Day Recognising Outstanding Women in Lifesaving awards. Erin has also had a starring role in the recent Nippers@home series published on the LSV facebook pages.

Additionally, we had three of our younger members complete their Gold Medallions and a number of patrollers offered roles as paid guards for LSV. These are just some of the achievements of our members, there have been many more.

I'd like to take this opportunity to call out a couple of new comers who, although not Committee Members have provided assistance in areas that are vital to our being able to offer the great programs that we do. A big thank you to **Katherine van den Broek**, who despite being a new Nipper parent, took on the role of updating and maintaining the Sorrento SLSC Nippers Proficiency & Awards Tables. An often cumbersome and difficult task, but more so when you are new. And another big thank you to **Sylvia Arends**, who despite being a new Nipper Grandmother, kindly volunteered to become our Carnivals Coordinator. As we all know, Carnival season was more challenging than usual this season and Sylvia's assistance was greatly valued and appreciated.

Finally, I'd like to thank all Members for the past year, all patrollers for the work they put into getting our beach safe over the season, and all Committee Members for the support and hard work they have put in this year. Special thanks to retiring Committee Members **Shane Britten**, who has provided us with many hours of his expertise in repairing boards tirelessly, and **Brett Irvine**.

Brett has been a Committee Member for many years acting as Nipper coordinator and Membership officer amongst other roles. He was also a key driver in the clubhouse upgrades a few years ago, ran the Bayswim for a number of years and in his capacity as Vice President the past couple of years, has been thoughtful and trusted advisor on a wide range of issues.

Thanks again to everyone for the past year. It's been great to see the club flourish and grow and we're all looking forward to seeing what 2020-21 will bring.

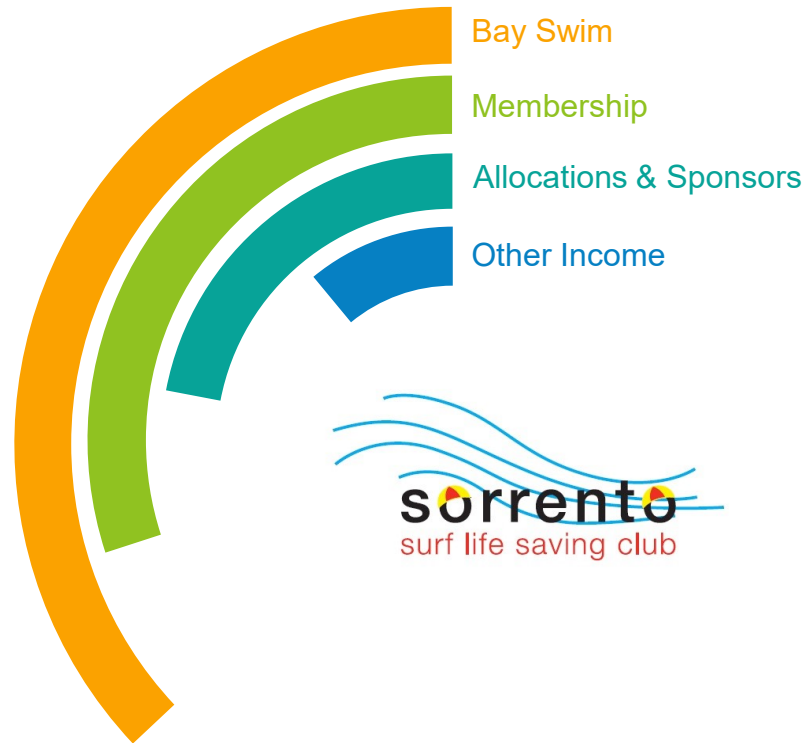

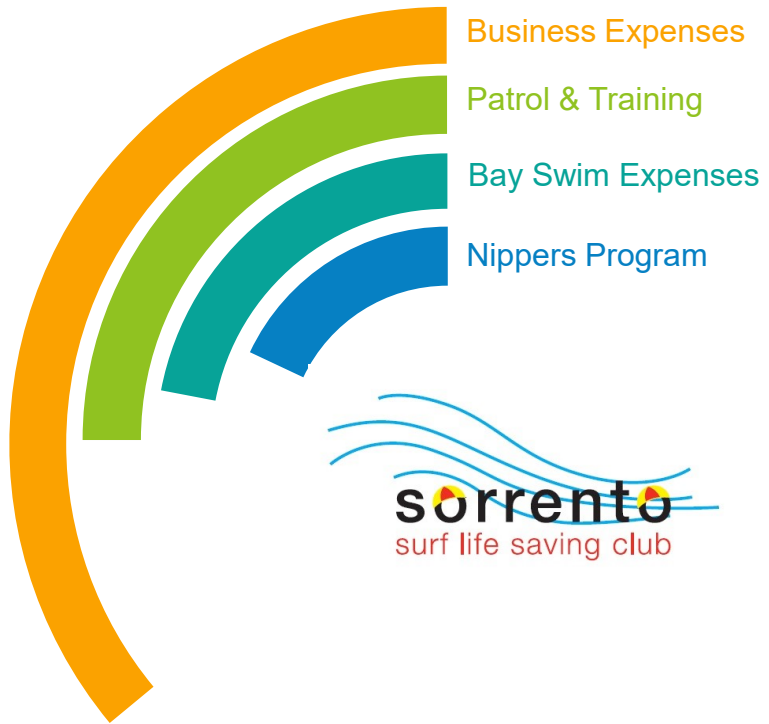

## CLUB CAPTAIN'S REPORT

Sorrento SLSC Lifesavers have had an unusual patrol season for 2019/20. An extraordinary summer bushfire season saw the Peninsula blanketed with smoke and then a global pandemic brought patrols to an abrupt halt. These events made for some unique challenges for our four (4) patrols over weekends and public holidays. Beach attendance was unsurprisingly down from last season, but patrollers remained vigilant as they performed 634 preventative actions. Rescues and first aids were down with attendance, but well done to everyone who participated in the 13 minor first aids, two major first aids or the solitary rescue. As Club Captain, I am very proud of how patrollers overcame the hurdles of the season to keep beachgoers safe.

Sorrento SLSC Lifesavers volunteered nearly 1500 hours of their time on the beach this season as active patrollers. Patrollers contributed an average of 24 hours each! This is an increase on the previous season and speaks to Sorrento's ability to rise to a challenge. Some patrollers deserve particular thanks from me personally for their leadership as patrol captains and vice-captains. Thank you to Patrol Captains: **Jeremy Doupe, Howard Draper and Oscar Morrison**; as well as their Vice-Captains: **Erin Doupe, Pete McDonell, Bruce Grayling, Stefan Bagg, Elissa Wright, Flynn Johnstone, Gerry Lute and Brody Britten**.









## CHIEF INSTRUCTOR'S REPORT

This season the Sorrento Training & Assessing team had to work hard on many fronts including as a result of the following:

- Most of the qualifications involve ATQF (i.e. Federally recognised training Units of Competency and Certificates). Our trainers and assessors had to satisfy LSV, who are a federally audited Registered Training Organisation, that we were suitably qualified and experienced. This involved completing an involved Matrix setting out the details of our training and assessing experience and ongoing training;
- The ATQF raised the standards for assessing and **Duncan Stirling, Marc Clavin, Peter McConnell** and **Stefan Baggs** had to complete an upskilling program to attain the new required Units of Competency. This involved several days training and many hours of independent work. They were all successful in this process and continued to be recognised assessors. **Howard Draper** went one step further and completed a Certificate IV in Training and Assessing. This took him 2 years of online and face-to-face training. If you think this is slow, he was the second person (out of 16) in his training cohort to complete the Cert IV;
- LSV tightened the underlying requirements for trainer and assessor skills to deliver and assess SRC and Bronze Courses, i.e. each trainer and assessor had to have a current competency in HLTAID001 (i.e. perform CPR). Accordingly, a number of our trainers and assessors had to update this Unit. LSV had decided that our yearly proficiency in this (i.e. requal) was not enough;
- Our team had suffered some significant losses in 2019 and our manpower was depleted.

Once we had dealt with all the above, we were able to deliver the following:

- On 20 October 2019, 6 Nipper parents obtained their Bronze Medallion (all candidates also received their Cert II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue) which includes Resuscitation);
- On 30 November 2019 - we requalified:
  - 17 Advanced Resuscitation Certificates;
  - 44 Bronze Medallion candidates;
  - 14 IRB crew & 9 drivers;
  - 5 SRC candidates;
- On 22 December 2019, 15 Junior Candidates obtained their Bronze Medallion (including Resuscitation);

- On 26 and 31 December 2019, we requalified 3 Bronze Medallion candidates. **Gerry Lute** also ran a boat course. One driver received his award. The assessment for the crew candidates are on hold due to COVID-19.
- On 4 January 2020, 14 Junior Candidates received their SRC awards (including Resuscitation);
- **Ro Moore** also arranged LSV to run a First Aid and CPR upskills course at the Club on 27 October 2019 which enabled a number of Members to either obtain the Cert II in First Aid or complete their skills maintenance in CPR.

Due to a reduction in our training and assessing team and qualification issues, we did not run a number of courses last season, e.g. ARTC (Advanced Resuscitation), ATV Certificate, Beach Management. We hope to be able to do these courses this year (note Spinal is no longer a qualification).

Keep an eye out for notifications in regards to upcoming Bronze, SRC, First Aid, CPR, and Boat Courses, together with the other speciality qualifications. We are looking forward to working with other clubs to enable us to provide some of these courses.

We have a very small team in reality – and some of us are getting rather old. Everyone worked very hard this season.

- In November 2019, thanks to a lot of planning work and co-ordination by **Marc Clavin**, a new security system was installed in the Clubhouse. This consisted of a new Member FOB system to open doors, multiple cameras and a new alarm system
- Thanks also to **Marc Clavin** for organising the installation of security screens on most windows in the main Clubroom area
- In April 2020, the main centre roof of the Clubroom was repaired. This consisted of removal of steel penetrations in the old roof, supply and installation of new colorbond roofing on affected areas and installation of laserlite roofing on roof over public men's toilets. Roof harness attachment points were also installed and
- Also in April 2020, and with thanks to **Ro Moore** for organising, the top of the limestone walls at entrance to the Clubhouse were repaired as they were badly in need of restitution.

## NIPPERS REPORT

We had a total of 161 Nippers participating in our 2019/20 season program, including 10 or so Nippers who successfully graduated the program and obtained their SRC, which allowed them to then join a surf lifesaving patrol (wearing their official patrollers' uniforms!).

The program commenced on 17 November 2019 with our swim evaluation and s-badge tests, and our last Nippers session was held on 16 February 2020, being our “family fun and presentation day”. Throughout the season, our team of age managers, water safety and other volunteers ran 12 Nippers sessions that covered all of the prescribed theory and practical sessions in the LSV Nippers program. These included the following sessions:

### **Theory & first aid lessons:**

- Basic first aid skills
- CPR demonstration and hands-on practice
- Identifying rips and different types of waves
- Understanding the hazards on our beach
- Sun safety, signals, learning what a lifesaving patrol does, etc.
- Tour of clubrooms

And most importantly, we also had the fun activities on the beach and in the water (which the Nippers all love), as per below. These were held at the St Paul’s Road front beach earlier in the season, and then at the Sorrento ocean road back beach:

### **Practical lessons:**

- Board paddling technique and races
- Swims – short and long
- Ironman / Ironwoman events (individual swim/run/board event)
- AquaCameron events (team events including wade/board/swim/run legs)
- Beach flags
- Beach sprints and relays
- Long beach runs

As described in more detail below in the Nipper Carnivals Report, as a club we also attended 3 Nippers carnivals, being Mordialloc, Point Leo and the State Championships at Warrnambool. At Point Leo we had something in the order of 35-40 Nippers competing against other clubs, with this being the first surf lifesaving carnival for many of our Nipper families. On the March long weekend, just before the COVID-19 lockdowns began, four of our Nippers competed at

the LSV Junior Lifesaving Championships at Warrnambool. What we lacked in size of team, we made up for in quality – winning 1 gold, 1 silver, and achieving 3 other top 10 finishes. Go Sorrento!!

Four of our 13 year old Nippers and former Nippers were selected to attend a LSV Development Camp at the end of March. They were **James Johnson, Ryan McKeown, Kalypso Tsoukalas Elphick** and **Oliver Brown**. Unfortunately this camp had to be cancelled as the COVID-19 pandemic took hold, but it was still great recognition for these kids to be nominated and accepted.

We love receiving feedback from Nipper parents, and it was pleasing that the feedback throughout the season was overwhelmingly positive. We have also surveyed parents in recent weeks to obtain further feedback, ideas and suggestions.

Late in the season, we formed a Nipper Working Group, consisting of 7 enthusiastic parents to coordinate the Nippers program going forward. We are looking to further improve the Nippers Program for next year, and to share the load among many more parents.

A special thanks must go to **Maesson Harbour**, our energetic and diligent water safety coordinator, who has filled that important role for a few years, and is now handing it over to his successor(s). Also, we owe a very deep thanks to **Bethany Orme**, a teenage bronze medallion holder and former Nipper, who ran a number of courses for our older age groups, including CPR, chain of survival and basic first aid. Bethany did a wonderful job and we look forward to seeing her back next season.

And finally, the Sorrento Nippers program is run entirely by volunteers, so it is imperative that every family plays a role in helping us to deliver a safe, inclusive and engaging experience for our kids. We are always in need of more volunteers for various roles, so please reach out to us at **Nippers@sorrentoslsc.com** if you can assist in any way – whether it is on the beach, in the water, as an official at a carnival, or behind the scenes helping us with social events, the BBQ, ordering supplies and various planning and administration type tasks.

Although it's not clear at this stage what the Nippers program will look like next year as a result of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, we are hopeful that the season will proceed in some form and we're looking forward to seeing everyone on the beach once again!
